

Holy Angels School offers an early childhood program during the regular school year. Eligible students must be 3 years old on or before September 1, 2019. Students entering our 4-year old program must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2018.

The early childhood program offers half-day sessions as well as full-day sessions that will meet five days per week.

The early childhood program is taught by:

- DPI certified, licensed early childhood / kindergarten teachers.
- Classrooms are supported by an instructional aide.
- An intervention teacher supports the teachers and students with individualized learning and skill assessments.

Holy Angels uses the Learning Without Tears© curriculum for language, literacy, numbers, and math.

Curriculum Based on Learning Without Tears© and Wisconsin Early Model Learning Standards

Our school uses the Learning Without Tears Program where learning is tailored to the child's learning style.

Our playful approach includes:

- Movement
- Manipulation of objects
- Building
- Singing
- Drawing
- Dramatic Play

Program modifications are made, based on the child's skill level. The State of Wisconsin uses the Wisconsin Early Model Learning Standards (WMELS). The developmental standards include:
